First Aid Training

During the school day and during school sponsored events, including those off-site, at least one person from each school, and every staff member who teaches or supervises students in classes or activities where, as determined by the district, students are exposed to dangerous equipment or chemicals or other increased risks of injury, shall have a current certification from a nationally recognized course in standard first aid and CPR. A list of such staff members shall be maintained in each school office.

All athletic coaches, as that term is defined by applicable rules of the Colorado State Board of Education, shall be certified in CPR and the use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs).
