Shared Schooling

(Home School Students)

The Board of Education shall grant all Kindergarten through Twelfth grade students currently participating in an authorized home school program to enroll part-time in the Archuleta School District 50 JT public school district. Students enrolled in an online school may be allowed to enroll part-time in Archuleta School District 50 JT only if they are considered half-time or less with the on-line school. Individual cases may be presented to the building principal, with final determination made by the superintendent.

The following requirements shall apply:

- 1. The student must have on file, in the district administration office, a home school notification form for the current school year and must be in compliance with all other requirements of the state home school law.
- 2. There must be room in the class for the student.
- 3. The student must be enrolled for enough class time for the school district to receive partial state funding. (At least one quarter time of a school year of teacher-pupil instruction and teacher-pupil contact.)
