

District Review Committee

The District Review Committee was founded in 1978 as a compromise alternate plan to the master contract idea. It was a result of negotiations by the School Board, Pagosa Springs Education Association and the administration. The committee provides a direct means of communication between all district employees and the Board of Education.

The District Review Committee of Archuleta School District 50 JT shall consist of the following:

- 1 - Classified representative for the middle school and the administration building
 - 1 - Classified representative for the elementary school
 - 1 - Classified representative for the high school
 - 1 - Maintenance and Transportation representative
 - 1 - Licensed representative for each campus
 - 1 - Administrator
 - 1 - Board member – shall serve as a non-voting ex-officio member of the committee
- The Superintendent - shall serve as a non-voting ex-officio member of the committee.

The members shall be nominated and elected by the group they represent. In the event no nominations are made by a representative group, the principal/supervisor shall have the authority to appoint a representative for the group. They shall serve basic terms of one year, and shall be surveyed each spring as to their willingness to serve one additional one-year term.

The specific charges and responsibilities of the committee shall be as follows:

1. To make recommendations to the Board of Education, Archuleta School District 50 JT relative to school board policy.
 - A. Changes in school personnel policies.
 - B. Improvement of working conditions of all employees.
2. To make recommendations to the Board of Education concerning the personnel decisions that are made by the Board, the administration, teachers, and others that affect the quality of education in the district.
