

Voting Method

At all meetings, voting shall be only upon roll call. The names of members shall be called alphabetically and each member shall vote “Yea” or “Nay”.

A member may abstain from voting only if excused by the Board for good cause.

Voting by secret ballot shall be prohibited, except for election of the president and vice president.

To pass, any motion must be approved by a majority of the members present except as state law or policies of this Board may require a majority of full membership.
