

Student Conduct on Buses

The driver of a school bus shall be responsible for safety of the students on the bus, both during the ride and while students are entering or leaving the vehicle. Students must follow the driver's instructions at all times. All bus drivers are bound by the School Bus Regulations, State of Colorado, and must enforce the accompanying rules in addition to the rules of the State of Colorado. Adult sponsors will assist the drivers in every way possible and are responsible for order.

It is the bus driver's duty to notify the supervisor of transportation and the principal of the school involved if any student persists in violating the established rules of conduct.

Buses shall run on predetermined schedules each school day. However, in cases of severe storm conditions or emergencies, students and parents should listen to Radio KWUF in the mornings to see if the buses will run.

Students participating in activities which require transportation away from the school district must accompany the team or group in buses or cars provided by the district, including the return trip, except when officially released by proper authority.
